KIPP Administrative Services Corporation administered the student enrollment lottery for **KIPP Philadelphia Charter School** on March 16th, 2017 at 2:00 PM. The lottery was held at 2409 West Westmoreland Street, Philadelphia, PA 19129.

All students who submitted a valid enrollment form prior to the March 1, 2017 open enrollment deadline were entered into the lottery. SchoolMint, a web-based enrollment and lottery management platform, was used to collect the forms and run the lottery. SchoolMint uses a random sequence generator to generate a sequence between one and the total number of students wishing to enroll in each grade. The numbers in the random sequence and the charter enrollment preferences determine the order in which students will be enrolled.


The lottery was conducted for students enrolling in K-8th grades. A total of 1974 students applied for 125 total open seats. Students were drawn for these open seats by grade and by charter preferences. KIPP Philadelphia Charter School charter preferences specify that founding family and employee children should be drawn first, followed by siblings of current students, followed by children of alumni, and lastly, all other students. The 125 open seats went to the first 2 founding family/employee students, 53 sibling students, 5 children of alumni students, and 65 no preference students. The remaining names were ranked in order for the waitlist.
