KIPP Administrative Services Corporation administered the student enrollment lottery for **KIPP DuBois Collegiate Academy** on March 16th, 2018 at 9:30 AM. The lottery was held at 5070 Parkside Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19131.

All students who submitted a valid enrollment form prior to the March 1, 2018 open enrollment deadline were entered into the lottery. SchoolMint, a web-based enrollment and lottery management platform, was used to collect the forms and run the lottery. SchoolMint uses a random sequence generator to generate a sequence between one and the total number of students wishing to enroll in each grade. The numbers in the random sequence and the charter enrollment preferences determine the order in which students will be enrolled.


The lottery was conducted for students enrolling in 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades. A total 562 of students applied for a total of 52 open seats (32 in 9th grade and 20 in 10th grade). Students were drawn for these open seats by grade and by charter preferences. KIPP DuBois Charter School charter preferences specify that founding family and employee children should be drawn first, followed by siblings of current students, followed by students in preferred zip codes, followed by children of alumni, and lastly, all other students. The 52 open seats went to 14 sibling students, 28 zip code students and 10 students with no preference. The remaining names were ranked in order for the waitlist.


