

KIPP Philadelphia Public Schools Virtual Guidelines

Daily Attendance: Student participation on zoom calls and online learning programs is required. Following PDE guidance for virtual learning, attendance will be taken for each Zoom session and for the completion of online work.

Dress Code: KIPP does not require students to be in uniform when they are participating in virtual learning. Students may wear casual clothes appropriate for school. Clothing should be free from profanity, references to drugs, alcohol and violent imagery.

Communication + Contact Information: There are several ways we will continue to communicate with our families during this time. Please make sure to keep your contact information current with your school including your phone numbers, email addresses, and home addresses. Please reach out to your schools' Director of Operations if you need to make updates. Grades and Report Cards: Students will be graded on a combination of assignments, online program completion, and class participation. Students will receive report cards based on this work on at the end of each grading term (Quarter for 9-12, Trimester for K-8). When KIPP is 100% virtual, report cards will be sent via ParentSquare.
